

Khalid Griggs

1. Khalid Griggs is the Muslim Chaplain at Wake-Forest University in Winston – Salem, North Carolina.¹
2. Khalid Griggs is the Imam at the Community Mosque in Winston-Salem.²
3. According to the Community Mosque of Winston-Salem, the mosque was founded by members of the Islamic Party of North America; Ibrahim Hanif, Jamal Abdullah, Salih Abdul Latif, and **Khalid Abdul Fattah Griggs**.³
4. The Islamic Party of North America claims that they are grounded in the teachings of tyrannical leaders and members of the Muslim Brotherhood. In their published mission statement, they claim their primary influences are: Maududi, Khomeini, Malik Bennabi, Qaddafi, and Sayyed Qutb.⁴
5. Khalid Griggs is the former Editor-in-Chief of the *Message Magazine*, a publication by the Islamic Circle of North America (ICNA).^{5 6}
6. Khalid Griggs has been a key speaker at several ICNA events.^{7 8 9}
7. Khalid Griggs holds chair position on the board for ICNA Council for Social Justice.¹⁰
8. The Islamic Circle of North America (ICNA) was included in a document submitted into evidence in the Holy Land Foundation Trial titled “A list of our organizations and the organizations of our friends,” which identified ICNA as being a friend and/or entity of the Muslim Brotherhood.¹¹
9. Khalid Griggs is on the Shura Council for Muslim Alliance of North America (MANA), an organization co-founded and operated by Siraj Wahhaj.^{12 13}
10. Siraj Wahhaj is an unindicted co-conspirator in the 1993 World Trade Center bombings.¹⁴

11. MANA uses language of conquest and exclusivity and specifically states that its goal is to establish strong Muslim communities in the U.S. that specifically meet the needs of Muslims.¹⁵
12. MANA also states that their goal is to implement Islam all over the world beginning with the erection of Masjids (mosques) as a sign of conquest.¹⁶
